Center for Corporate Governance invites you to a seminar with Stanford professor of finance and economics, Anat Admati, who will give a public lecture about “The Intertwined crises of Capitalism and Democracy”.

Professor Admati is among those who has been on Time-magazine list of 100 most influential people in the world. In this seminar, she will talk about how debates about our economic system are sometimes framed, at least in the political discourse in the US and elsewhere, as a stark choice between “free market capitalism” and “big government socialism.” This framing is misguided and unhelpful. It overlooks the essential role of many institutions, including in the government, for enabling markets to work at scale. In this talk, Prof. Admati will explain the key forces and offer insights into the apparent crises of trust in both capitalism and democracy. Understanding the challenges of striking the right balance between the state and the private sector is a first step towards creating a trustworthy system.
